



What is the Camana Bay Corporate 3v3 League?

The Camana Bay Corporate 3v3 Coed Basketball League is a recreational league designed to inject a dose of fun, friendly competition, and physical activity into our corporate environment. Embracing the principles of inclusivity, the league is open to players of all skill levels, making it an ideal platform for both seasoned athletes and those new to the game. Whether you're a three-pointer maestro or a novice dribbler, this league is your chance to shine on the court.

League Overview:

Competition Sponsor: Camana Bay, who's Sports Complex Team will coordinate the competition.

Entry fee: C/\$180.00 per team.

Location: All games are scheduled to be played at the Camana Bay Outdoor Basketball Courts.

Competition Duration: 7 weeks (5 weeks of regular season and 2 weeks of playoffs).

Dates/Times: Tuesdays between 6:00pm and 8:00pm. The league will run from Tuesday, April 2nd through Tuesday, May 21st, 2024.

Who is eligible to Play?: Employees of participating companies are eligible to play.

Is the competition coed?: Yes, each team can have players of any gender. While there is no requirement to have a particular number of female players on the court at any time, points scored by female players will be worth more.

Who will officiate games?: We will provide referees to officiate the games.

Key Details:

Scoring: Males - 1 point inside the arc and 2 points outside the arc. Free throws are worth 1 point. Females - 2 points inside the arc and 3 points outside the arc. Free throws are worth 2 points.

Breaks: There are no breaks. Once a point is scored, the ball doesn't stop. Offence turns to defense and play continues.

Possession: A coin flip is performed to determine who gets first possession. Possession is kept after a free throw

Free throws:

If the foul is committed on a player not in the act of shooting:

- The game will be resumed with a check-ball by the non-offending team.
- If the offending team is on their 7th team foul, 2 free throws are awarded.

If the foul is committed on a player in the act of shooting:

- If the shot is released from the field goal area is successful, the goal counts and 1 free throw is awarded. (2 free throws awarded if on the 7th team foul).
- If the shot released from inside the arc is unsuccessful, 1 free throw is awarded. (2 free throws awarded if on the 7th team foul).
- If the shot is released from behind the arc is unsuccessful, 2 free throws.

Length of games: Games will be either 10 minutes or the first team to reach 21 points (win by 2 points if it is a tie).

Number of players: 3 players will be required to be present to start a game. Each team is allowed 1 substitute. Therefore, each team is permitted to have a maximum of 4 players per team.

Weather Protocol

In the event that there is weather that prevents play, the game schedule will be postponed by one week and resume the following Tuesday.

- If lightning strikes, teams will clear the courts
- Games can be continued if no lightening has struck for 20 minutes
- If games have not restarted within 30 minutes of the original start time, they will be called off
- If the courts are flooded due to rain, the games will be called off

Please be reminded that fair play and sportsmanship should be displayed at all times.

Both teams will be given a scorecard to be completed and at the end of the game the team captains will meet to ensure their scorecards match. The cards will then be turned in to Camana Bay security for logging by the CBSC team.
