Under 14 Inter-school Leagues

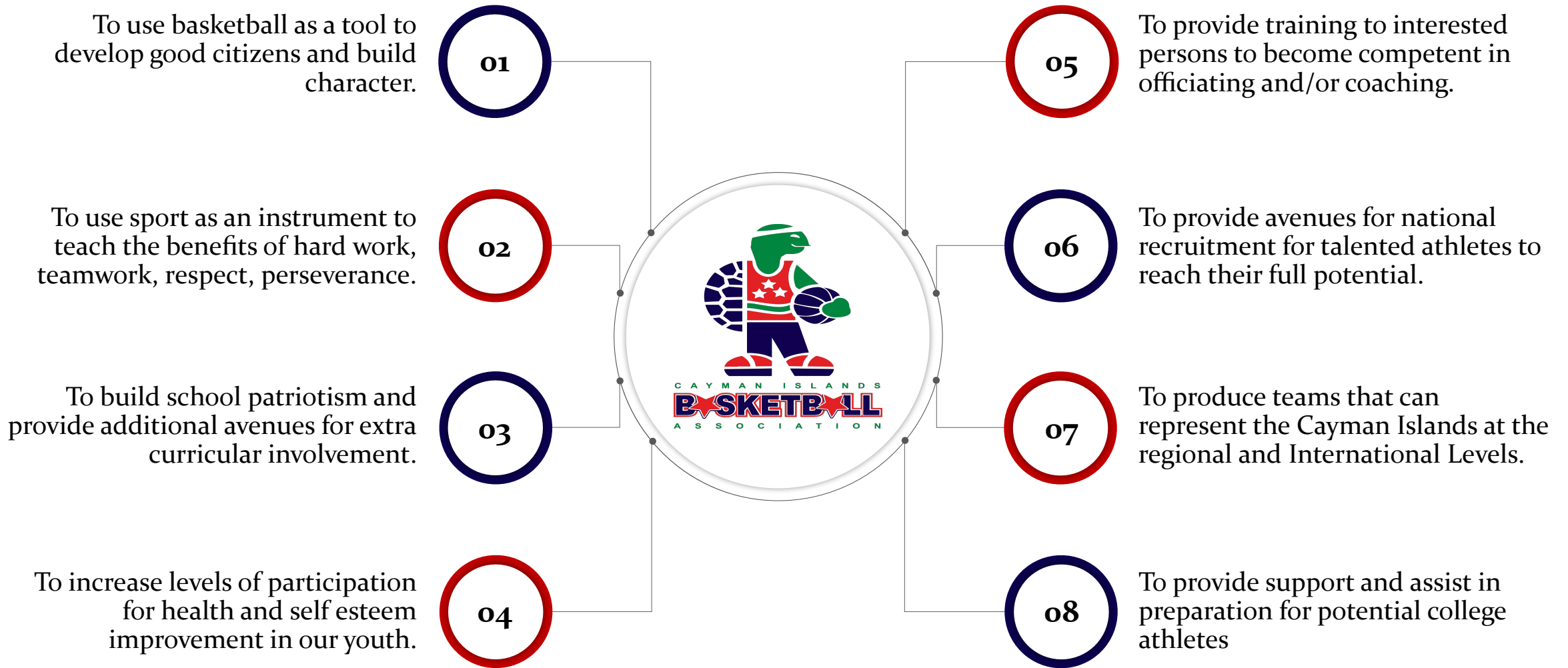
Under 16 Boys and Girls Leagues

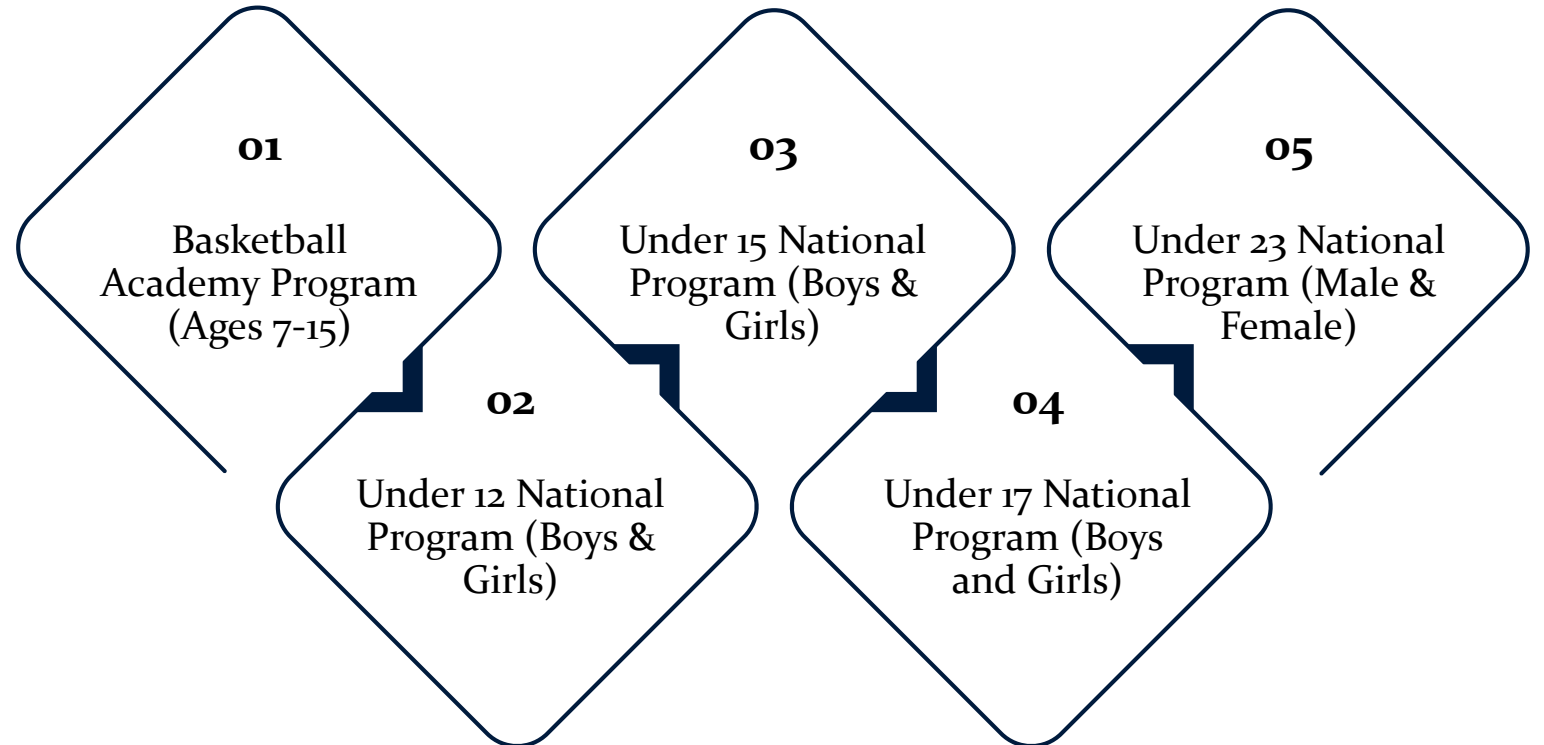

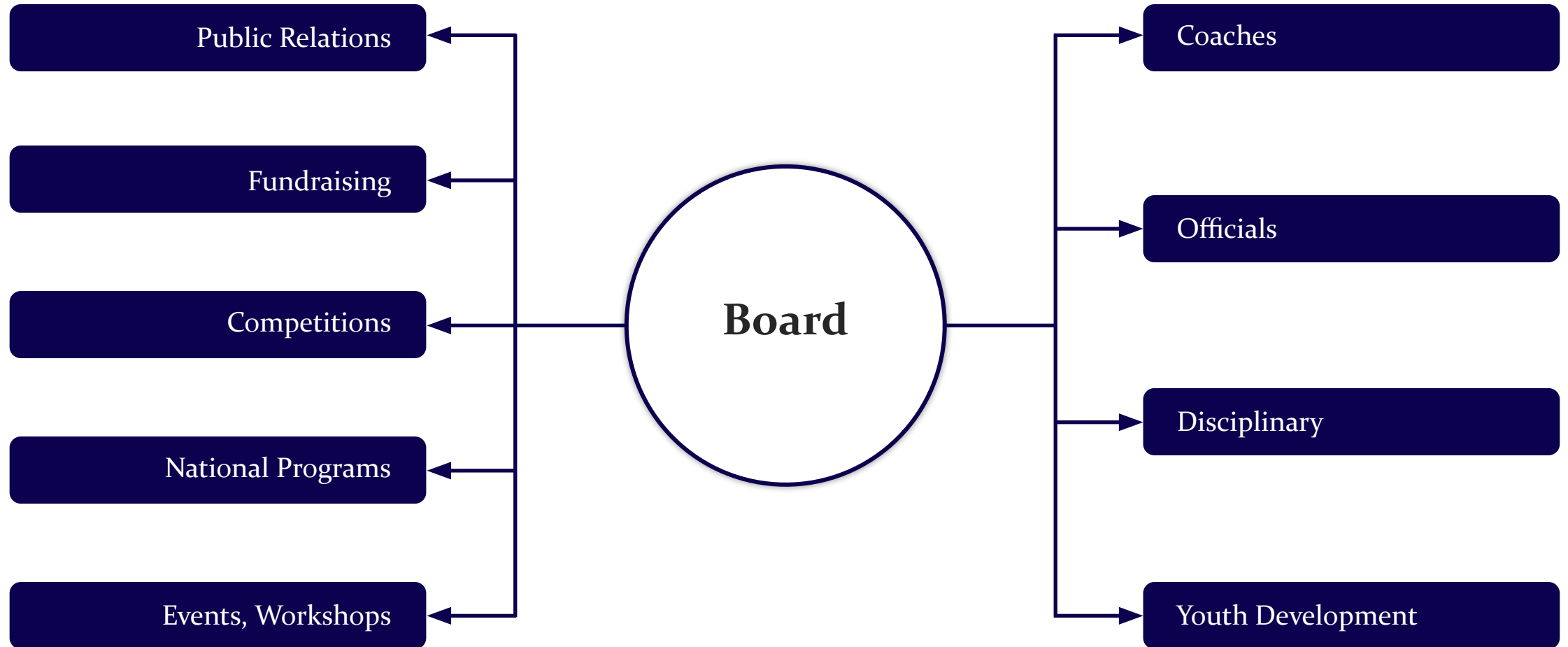
