## Player Code of Conduct

---

I understand and commit to upholding the highest standards of behavior, sportsmanship, and respect. This Athlete Code of Conduct outlines the expectations and responsibilities I have as a representative of my team and the game of basketball.

### 1. Respect for Others:

- I will treat coaches, teammates, opponents, officials, parents, and fans with respect, regardless of their background or role.
- I will refrain from using profane language, engaging in verbal abuse, or exhibiting disrespectful behavior.

### 3. Positive Attitude:

- I will support and encourage my teammates and contribute to a positive team environment.

### 4. Attendance and Punctuality:

- I will attend all practices, games, and team-related activities unless there is a legitimate reason for absence.
- I will be punctual and arrive on time for all team commitments.

### 5. Effort and Commitment:

- I will give my best effort in every practice and game, striving for continuous improvement.
- I will commit to the team's goals and values and work towards achieving them.

### 6. Self-Discipline

- I will adhere to team rules, guidelines, and curfews set by coaches and staff.
- I will avoid engaging in any behavior that might reflect negatively on the team or the sport of basketball.

### 7. Cooperation and Communication:

- I will communicate openly with coaches and teammates, discussing concerns or issues in a respectful and constructive manner.

- I will follow the instructions of coaches and team leaders during practices and games.

8. Appearance and Uniform:

- I will wear the team uniform with pride and ensure it is clean and well-maintained.
- I will present myself in a professional manner that reflects positively on the team and the sport.

9. Academic Responsibility (if applicable):

- I will prioritize my education and fulfill all academic responsibilities.
- I will manage my time effectively to balance academics and basketball commitments.

10. Use of Technology and Social Media:

11. Health and Safety:

- I will take care of my physical and mental health, seeking help or support when needed.

12. Representation and Leadership:

- I will lead by example, both on and off the court, demonstrating qualities of sportsmanship, integrity, and leadership.
